The Department of Economics, Management and Quantitative methods is seeking candidates for the position of a two-years fellowship (possibly renewable) for a collaboration to research activity on the topic **“Development banks: performance, governance, and participation in the market for corporate control”**.

Deadline: November 15th 2016 at noon.

Requirements: PhD (to be earned before February 28th, 2017).

Salary: 21,000 euro per year, income tax exempt.

Starting date: March 2017.

Candidates will have to submit a research project, and will be evaluated on the basis of their CVs, projects, and interviews. Fluent English, but not Italian, is a requirement.

Your tasks:

- conduct empirical research within the project “Development banks: performance, governance, and participation in the market for corporate control”, in cooperation with the project leaders and other team members in the project;
- engage in joint scientific research together with the project leaders and other team members in the project;
- participate in the organization of research activities and events (eg. conferences, workshops);
- regularly present intermediate research results at international conferences and workshops;
- write scientific articles and conference papers jointly with the project leaders and other team members in the project.

Your profile (desirable):

- PhD in Banking, Finance, Economics, or related field;
- skills and experience in quantitative research methods and empirical research in banking and finance;
- skills and experience in using quantitative data analysis packages (eg. STATA);
- skills in dealing with micro-level database (eg. Datastream, Bloomberg, Zephir, Orbis, Bankscope) or willingness to gain know-how in this area.
