Due to the pandemic, the EU industrial system has suffered a negative economic impact. Against this background, the European Commission considered it necessary to update the industrial strategy to encourage the revival of European industry using lessons learned from the pandemic crisis. There is a need to accelerate companies' green and digital transformation and strengthen the European single market compared to the dependencies on international markets for some supply chains. The European Commission, therefore, has identified 14 ecosystems that make up the European industrial system, with the aim, among others, to know in detail the needs of each sector, effectively intervening to accelerate the digital and green transition. This study aims to analyse, using appropriate indicators, the interconnections between the different industrial ecosystems. Also, to understand if economic relations exist even in the face of development and investment policies that the European Commission intends to launch.
